She is celebrated for saving the lives of soldiers from both sides without discrimination and in helping some 200 Allied soldiers escape from German-occupied Belgium during the First World War, for which she was arrested. She was subsequently court-marshaled, found guilty of treason and sentenced to death. Despite international pressure for mercy, at the age of 49 years she was shot by a German firing squad. She is well known for her statement that patriotism is not enough.
